



## Terms of Reference 2018

### 1. Scholarships

The Arnold Heidsieck Scholarship Fund will award 4 – 5 scholarships in the U.S. to aid with travel and living costs. The Fund will offer a monthly grant of up to USD 550 for a maximum stay of 10 months, plus a travel allowance of up to USD 1,100.

The Arnold Heidsieck Scholarships can be combined with other sources of funding. If the applicant is the recipient of another scholarship aside from the ZEIT-Stiftung, this information must be included in the application.

### 2. Eligibility

Eligible scholarship applicants must:

- a) Be German or foreign students who are currently enrolled at a German university.
- b) Be BA-students in the humanities with a focus on German culture, language, history, music, or art in their studies.
- c) Be working on their bachelor degree currently, or travel to the U.S. in the school year immediately after they have completed their bachelor's degree.
- d) Be accepted to a one-year-study at a U.S. university. Shorter stays may be supported by the Fund, but they will be assessed through a separate, case-by-case process.

### 3. Deadline

The final date for scholarship application is **5 April 2018** for scholarships beginning in August/September 2018.

### 4. Information required

The application must be submitted in English on the appropriate form provided by the ZEIT-Stiftung before the deadline. It must contain:

- A completed application form
- Curriculum Vitae
- Copy of High School Diploma (Abiturzeugnis)
- Transcript of Records (Leistungsübersicht aus dem BA-Studium)
- Essay explaining your motivations and why you should be considered for a scholarship (max. 2 pages)
- One letter of recommendation from a university professor sent directly from the author (in English or German)

Award recipients will be announced by the beginning of May, 2018.
